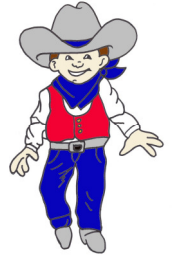

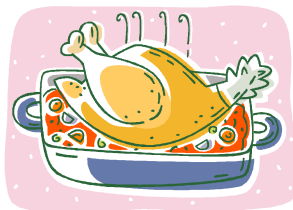

Dear Parents/Guardians and Menger Students,

Below are some reminders that will help our students be successful!

**ATTENDANCE PROCEDURES for CCISD Students, 2009-2010:**

**Daily Attendance and Partial Day Absences Elementary**

A student present at the time of daily attendance, but who is absent from school for part of a day (for example: tardy in the morning, or picked up early in the afternoon) for more than 15 minutes is considered missing part of a school day and will be counted as a partial day absence.

When a student is absent, the parent or guardian must call the school office that day to report the reason for the absence.

If a call is not received, the school will call your home or place of employment. Absences of 5 consecutive days will require a doctor's excuse and may require a home visit by school personnel.

**Within 2 days** of returning to school, the parent must submit a written note giving the reason for the student's absence. In order to determine if the absence is excused, a note is needed which includes date(s) and reason for the absence. The note must be signed by the student's parent or guardian.

Home visits will be made by our attendance clerk, school administrator, or truant officer to follow up on irregular attendance. Other home visits will be made as necessary or when requested by the staff. Excessive absences and tardies will require court action. If a student has established a questionable pattern of absences, the principal or the attendance committee may also require a physician's or clinic's statement of illness after a single day's absence as a condition of classifying the absence as one for which there are extenuating circumstances.
